
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

Pigs-in-a-Blanket

Ingredients:

- cocktail hot dogs (enough for each student to have one or two)
- 4 packages of refrigerated crescent-shaped rolls

Equipment:

- small cookie sheets
- toaster oven (If a standard oven is available, a large cookie sheet can be used.)
- plastic knives

Directions:

- Remove rolls from package. If necessary, cut them into smaller triangles proportionate to the size of the hot dogs. Place one miniature hot dog on each flattened crescent roll triangle.
- Roll dough around hot dog. Bake according to directions on package until dough is golden brown.
- Optional: Provide mustard and catsup for added taste.

Pink Lemonade

Prepare pink lemonade as directed on container.

Serve in paper or plastic cups.

Quick-and-Easy Fruit Shake

Ingredients:

- 2 cups (500 mL) vanilla ice cream
- 1 orange
- 1 (16 oz./450 g) can fruit cocktail
- 2 cups (500 mL) pineapple-orange juice

Equipment:

- bowl
- blender
- mixing spoon

Directions:

Before using the orange, remove the peel and any seeds. Place the orange, vanilla ice cream, fruit cocktail, and pineapple-orange juice in a blender. Cover and blend the ingredients until smooth. Pour the shakes into paper or plastic cups.

Buttermilk Pancakes

Mrs. Zuckerman gave Wilbur a buttermilk bath just before the fair. Prepare and serve buttermilk pancakes using any commercial brand of buttermilk pancake mix. Follow directions on package and serve with "Quick-and-Easy Fruit Shake."
