When you are finished, let a classmate see the cover of your new book. See if he or she can infer from your illustrations where the new book will take place.

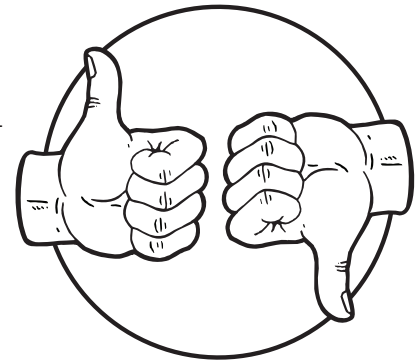

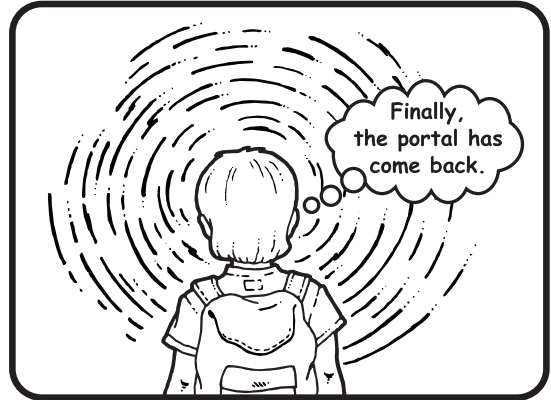
