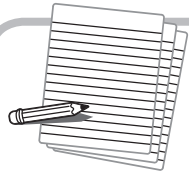


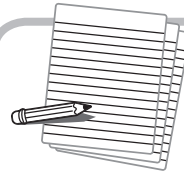
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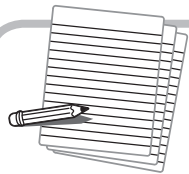

Would the singing ever stop? It was driving Sam crazy! . . .



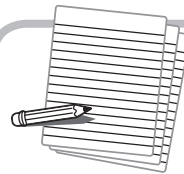

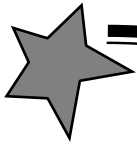
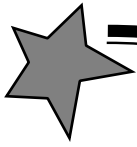


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What's the Big Idea?

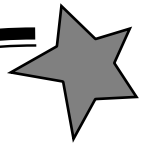
