two **antennae** or feelers on top of its **head** help a butterfly touch and smell?

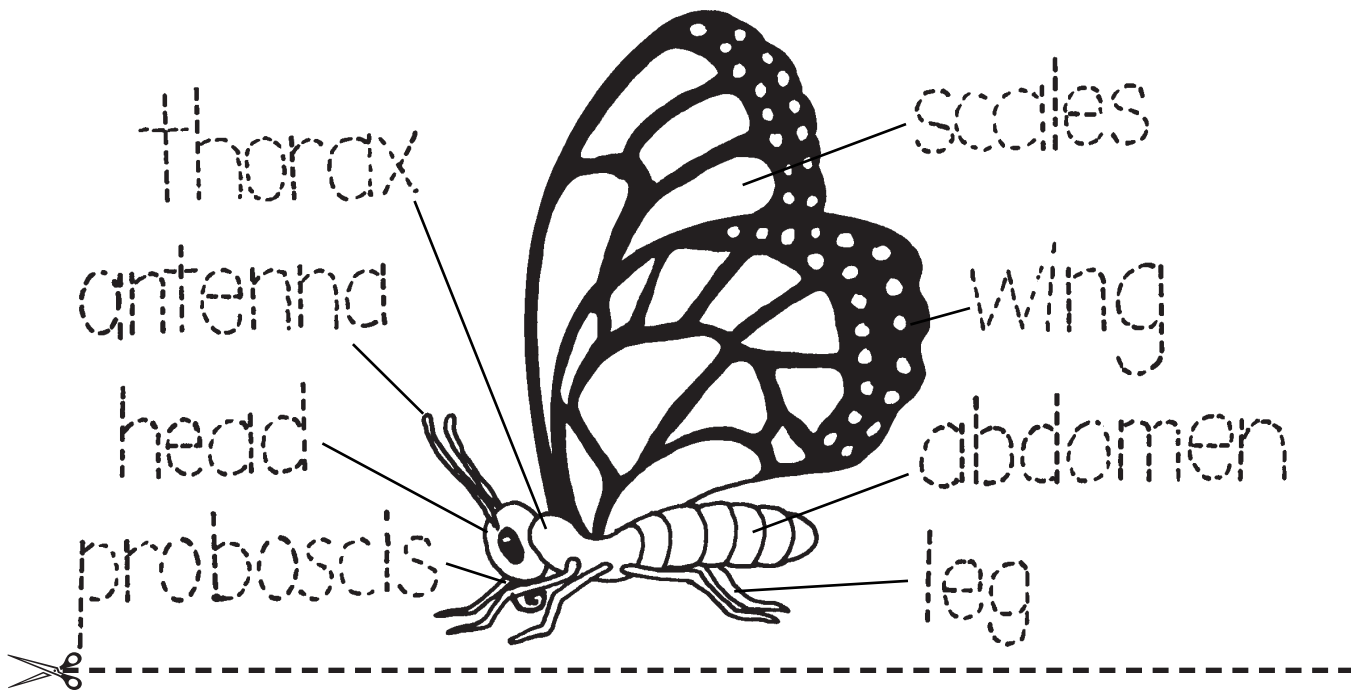
tiny **scales** make the color in a butterfly's wings?

the stomach can be found inside a butterfly's **abdomen**?



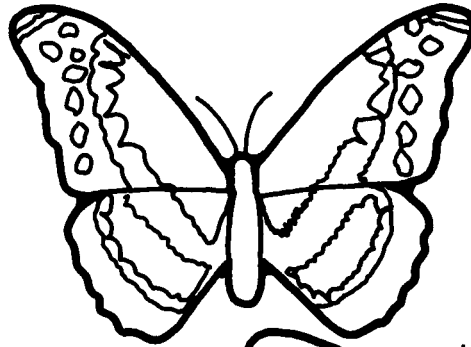
Cut off and ask your child these questions: (Answers have been provided in parentheses for easy reference.)

3. What does the butterfly use to drink nectar? (proboscis or mouth)
4. In which section of the butterfly can the stomach be found? (abdomen)
5. What body part helps the butterfly fly? (wings)
6. Which body part is used to touch and smell? (antennae)

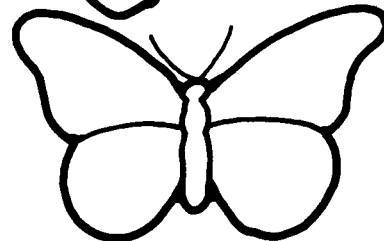
A World of Butterflies

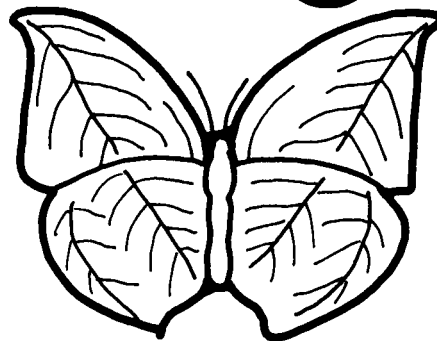
The **Blue Morpho's** metallic-blue wings are sometimes used to make jewelry. It is found only in the tropical jungles of **South America**.



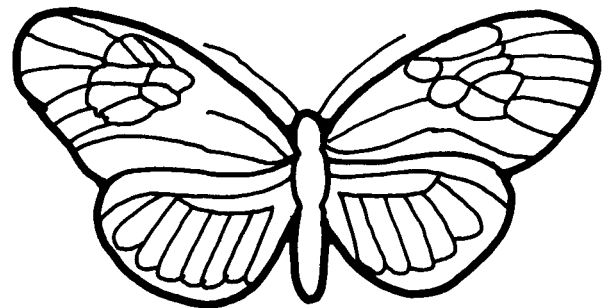
Bright orange wings help the **Orange Albatross** blend into the colorful flowers in the rain forests of **South America**.



The brown **Kallima butterfly** from **India** can imitate a dry leaf.



Colored brown, yellow, and red, **Postman** butterflies of **Central** and **South America** feed first on yellow flowers. Then they move on to red flowers.



Mexico is home to nature reserves where orange and black **Monarch** butterflies spend the winter.
