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
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Shape Slap


Directions:

Shapes:




Game Board:


- 1. Find a partner.

Addition Challenge

Directions:

- 1. Pick a colored pen. Have your partner pick a different color.
- 2. One player is on the left, and one player is on the right.
- 3. Look at the numbers in the middle. In each row, circle the numbers on your side that add up to the number in the middle. You can circle as many numbers as you need. For example:



- 4. Once you have circled any combination of numbers, put an **X** on the number in the middle. That row is now closed. You get a point for each **X**.
- 5. Start at the same time, and solve as many rows as you can before your partner.
- 6. You do not have to solve the rows in order. (You can start at the end or skip around.)
- 7. At the end, the person with the most points wins.
