## Picture Noun Pick



### Skill


Students will match Picture Noun cards to the printed word cards.

#### Grouping

- independent
- pairs
- small group

#### **Materials**

- Word Cards (pages 71–79)
- Picture Cards (page 81–89)



#### **Directions**

- 1. Choose 10 Word Cards and the matching Picture Cards. For beginning readers, start with just a few Word and Picture Cards. Place them face up on a flat surface.
- 2. Mix up the cards.
- 3. In turn, have each student pick a Picture Card, say the name of the picture, and place it with the correct Word Card. Encourage students to look at the beginning letter of the word to help find the correct word. If the match is correct, then the student gets to keep the cards. If the match is incorrect, then the cards must be placed back into the center.
- 4. As an option, have students record their matches on page 70.

#### **Suggestions**

- Have students create their own picture nouns using the boxes on page 70. Have them each draw a picture in the box on the left and write the word in the right box. To extend this activity further, have students create their own dictionaries. Have them each write one letter per piece of paper and then staple all 26 papers together. Then, have them glue their picture nouns inside according to the beginning letter.
- Glue the Picture Cards to the Word Cards. (Note: Make color copies of the Picture Cards if you want to use them for other activities.) Fold the Word Cards on the dashed lines. Have students hide the pictures and try to read the words only. After they have made guesses, have them unfold the pictures to see if their guesses were correct.
- Have students categorize the Picture Cards using the charts on pages 91 and 93.
- Use the Picture Cards with the activity on page 97.
