Paper Plate Sunflower

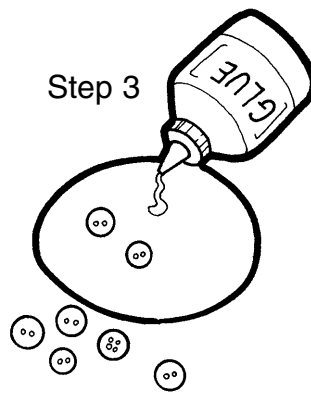


Materials

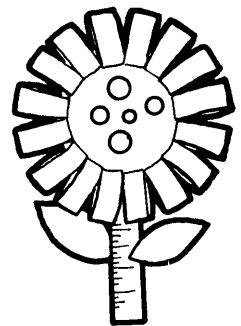
- Paper plate
- 2 yards (1.8 cm) of 1 ½" (3.75 cm) yellow ribbon, cut into 5" (12.5 cm) lengths
- Paint stirrer stick or old wooden ruler
- Sunflower seeds or brown buttons
- Glue
- Cardboard or poster board
- Brown and green tempera paint
- Paintbrush

Let's Do It !!

1. Cut a 5" (12.5 cm) circle from the center of a paper plate. Paint the circle brown and let it dry.
2. Glue the ends of the ribbon strips to form loops. Let the loops dry and then glue them around the edge of the blossom.
3. Glue buttons or sunflower seeds to the center of the blossom.
4. Glue the flower to the top of the ruler.
5. Cut two leaf shapes from the cardboard and glue them to the ruler (stem). Paint the leaves and the stem green.

More Ideas

- Use strips of yellow construction paper or manila envelope as petals.



Paper Plate Pal

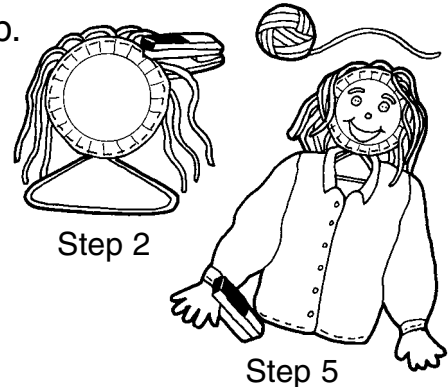


Materials

- Two paper plates
- Wire hanger
- Long-sleeved shirt
- Stapler
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers
- Yarn
- Construction paper

Let's Do It !!

1. Draw a face on the bottom of a paper plate.
Glue yarn hair to the plate.
2. Place the face plate over the hook portion of a hanger. Place the other paper plate face up under the hook. Staple the rims of the plates together.
3. Hang the shirt on the hanger and button it up.
4. Stuff the shirt sleeves and body with crumpled newspaper. Staple the shirrtail front to the back.
5. Make hands from the construction paper and staple them to the shirt cuffs, also stapling the cuffs together.



More Ideas

- Use buttons for eyes and yarn for eyebrows.
- Make a twin. Cut the face out of an 8" x 10" photograph of yourself and glue it to the bottom of a paper plate. Then, complete the directions as listed above.
