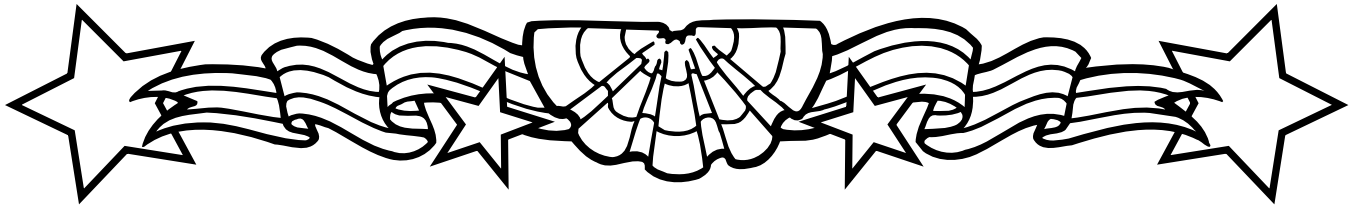


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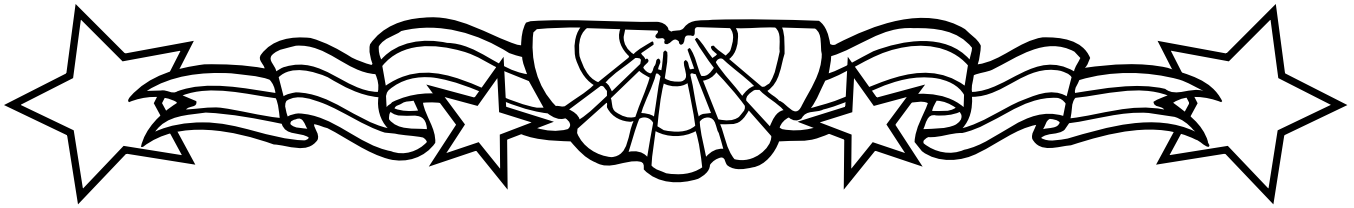


President Washington

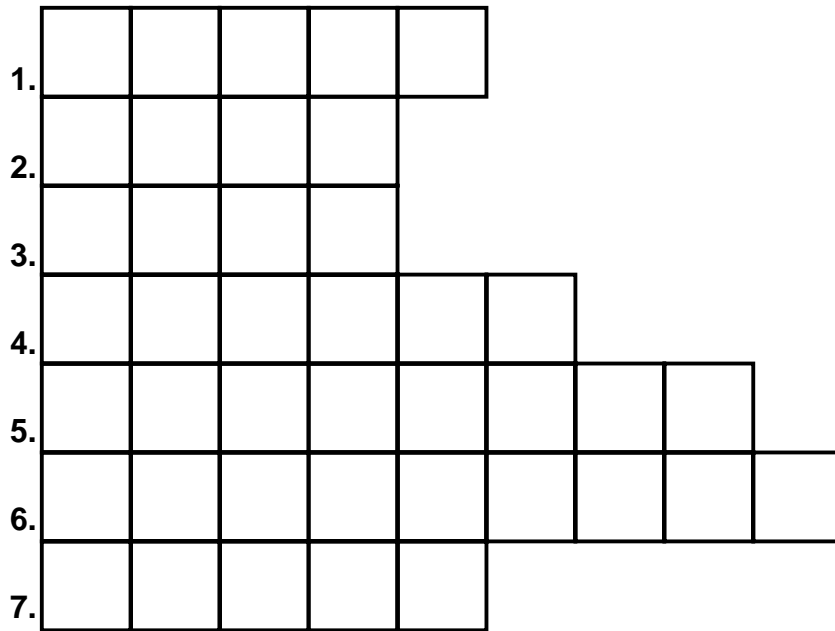
Read the story. Find the underlined words in the word search puzzle. Words may be down, across, diagonal or backwards.
