There is a lot of food this time of year. Deer need to fatten up. This will help them **survive** the next season. Fall is the time to chow down!

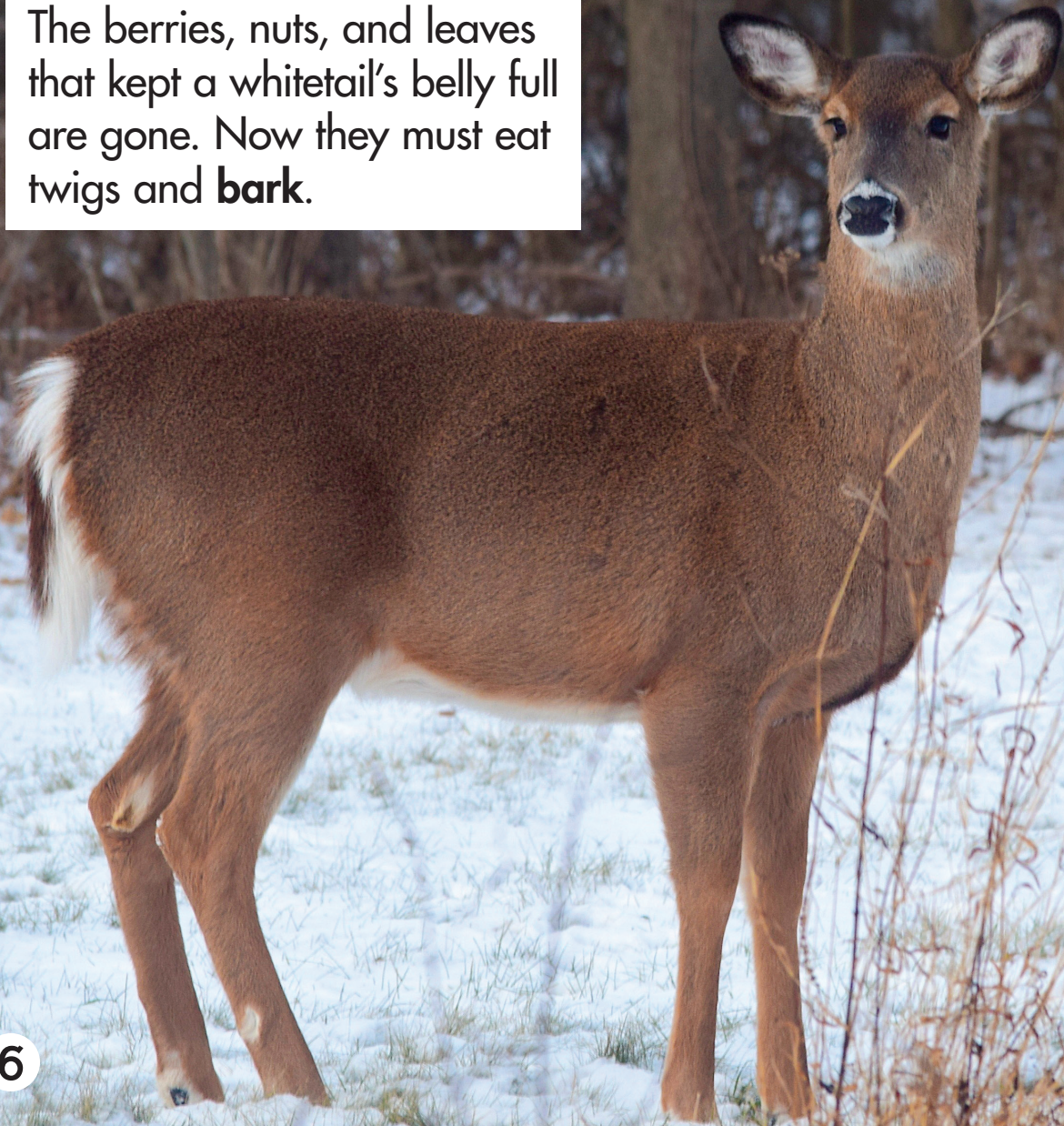


BE SURE TO EAT A LOT! WINTER IS JUST AROUND THE CORNER.
