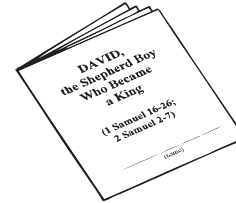






**Final Product**


Saul grew jealous of David and chased David all over the land to kill him.
