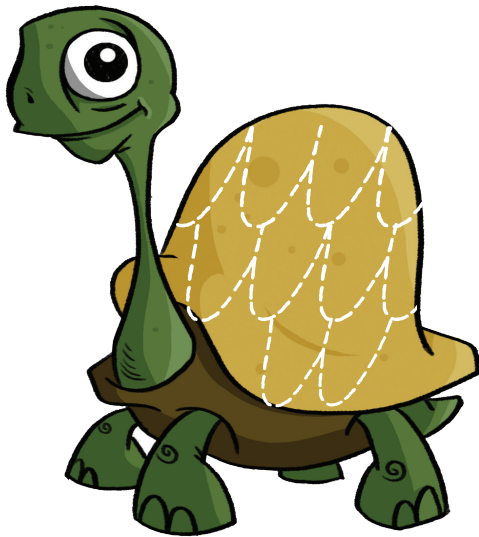

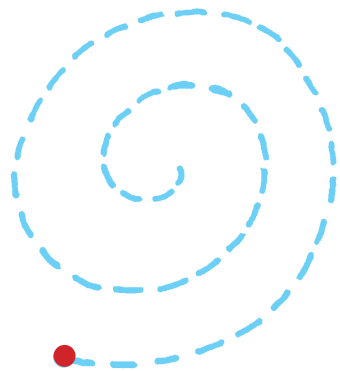


Can you trace these?

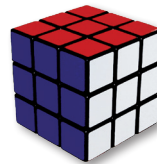
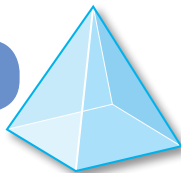
