#### Introduction

Write On – Wipe Off books are engaging, versatile learning tools that can be enjoyed over and over again. The colorful pages are highly durable and allow for easy erasing. These books work with all dry-erase markers and resist ghosting—the remnants of faint print marks. Fill each page and then just wipe away and start again! To ensure your child can use these pages many different times, make sure they erase their writing fairly quickly after the ink dries. Do not leave writing on the page for an indefinite amount of time, otherwise it may be hard to erase.

Looking for objects hidden in pictures can be a great deal of fun for young learners. At first, they may need help, but with each new find, their confidence will grow. Soon, they will be doing the pages by themselves!

Finding hidden pictures also develops a number of very important learning concepts young learners will need in school. Here are just a few of the skills searching for hidden pictures can help develop:

- · attention to detail
- · concentration
- matching
- · visual discrimination
- vocabulary

Most of the activities in this book provide a box at the bottom of the page with a collection of objects that are hidden in the picture above. The other pages have written directions at the top guiding students to find a certain number of items. Look through the pages with your child and do a few together to get started.


