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## Introduction

Sight words are the most frequently used words in the English language. In order to read fluently, a child must be able to read each sight word at a glance, and not need to sound it out. Since sight words are not always spelled phonetically, they must be memorized.

A variety of fine-motor-skill activities are provided to help children practice reading, writing, and spelling these important little words. These activities include:
tracing the words
"rainbow writing" by choosing a different color for each letter of the word * coloring in bubble letters to complete each word
filling in boxes to practice writing letters in appropriate sizes and noticing the "shape" of each word
filling in missing letters to complete the spelling of each word

circling, crossing out, and coloring to complete prompts for specific words
Try to reinforce each new word by discussing it with your child and comparing it to other words.

- How many letters are in the word? What shape is the word?
- How many vowels does the word have?
- Does the word look or sound similar to other words you know?

Review pages follow every five or six new sight words for additional practice. These include coloring, counting, and graphing activities. "Fill in the missing word" sentence pages follow the 100 sight words pages to encourage young learners to use their new sight words correctly.

The goal of these varied activities is to provide practice learning to recognize and spell the first 100 sight words. Set aside a special time each day to practice, and, if possible, establish a quiet "work space" free of other distractions. Most importantly, work together to make this practice time special.
