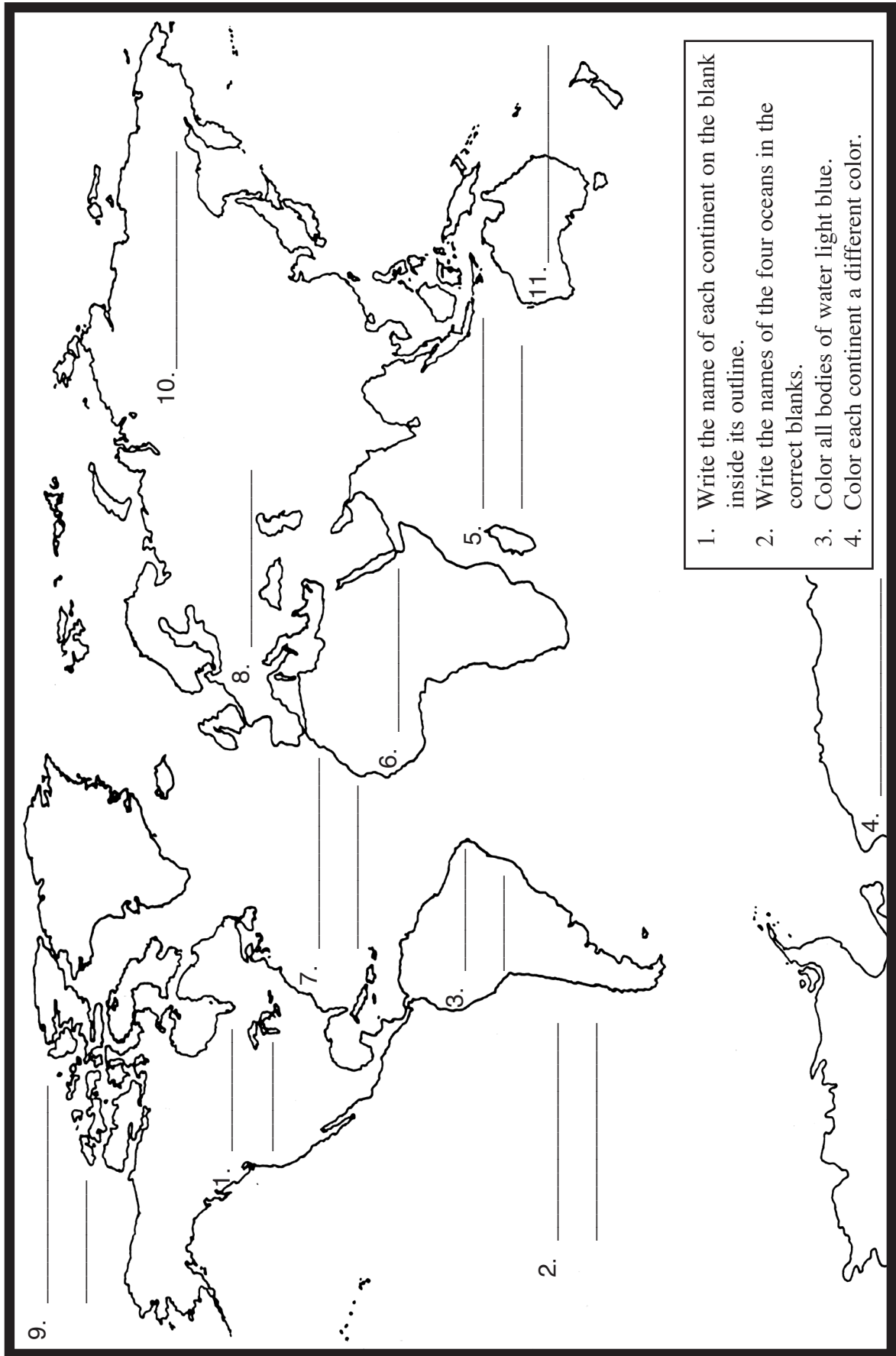
Note that students will need reference materials, such as encyclopedias and atlases to complete these pages.

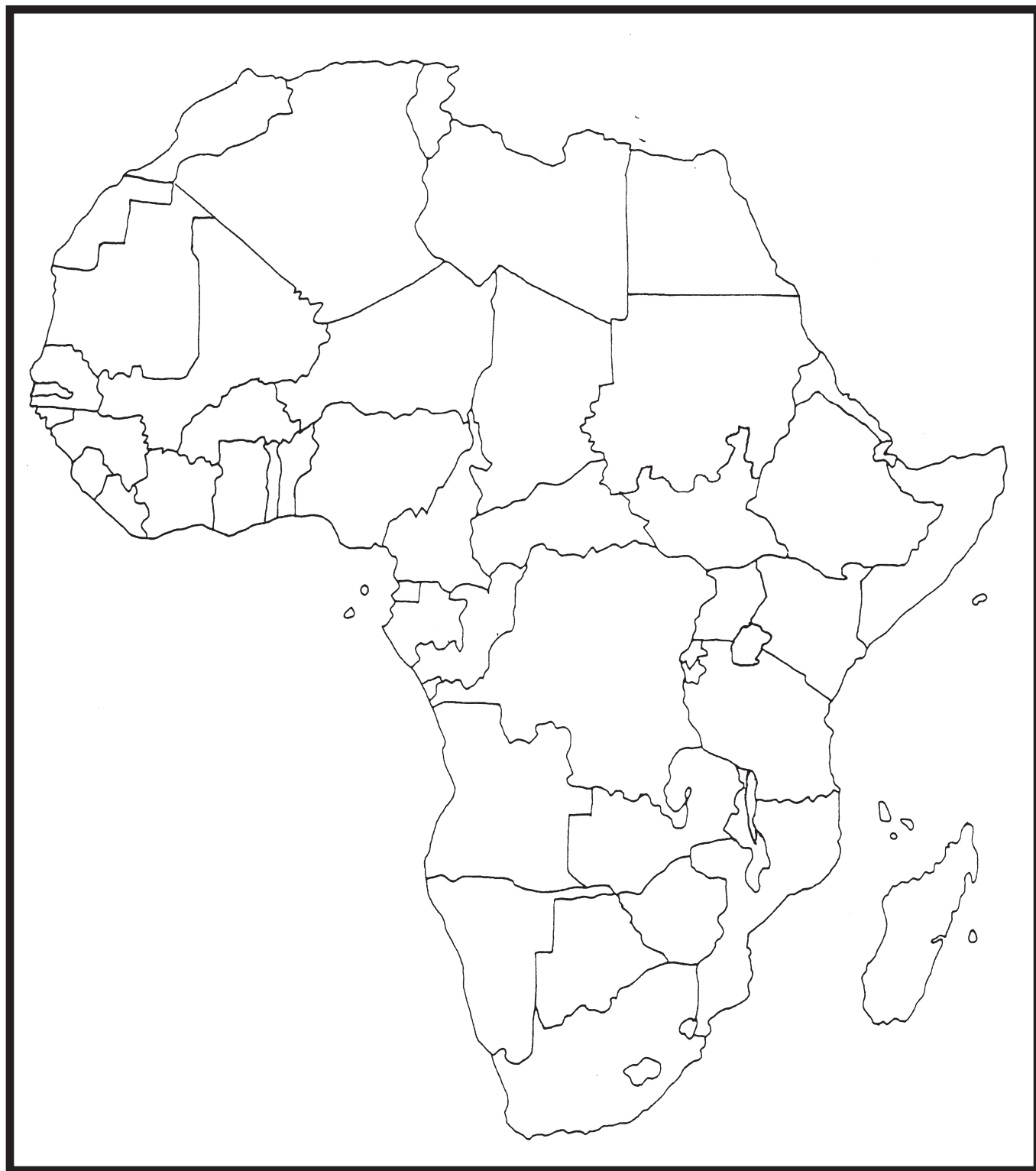
